

OBITUARY.

Mrs. Apphia McCoy was born in Scipio, Yates county, N. Y., Jan. 19, 1823, and died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Mascho, in Brookfield, Pa. Dec. 9, 1893.

Mrs. McCoy came to this state and county with her parents in her girlhood days and for nearly a life time has been well and favorably known in this community and vicinity. In 1841 she was united in marriage with Mr. Hiram McCoy. In the happy bond of this union they walked together for a half century after the lapse of which he was removed two years in advance of her, to his heavenly home. Seven children were gathered under their family roof to share her affectionate care and godly counsels: Three of these survive her and are well known in the community.

In early life she consecrated herself to God and gave her name to the Methodist Episcopal church, in the fellowship of which she walked until she was called from the church militant to the church triumphant.

On account of poor health for many years past, her time has been largely spent in the seclusion of her own home. But with christian fortitude she bore her sufferings and patiently waited for the end.

Her funeral services were conducted at her late home and her remains were tenderly laid to rest, by the side of her husband, in the Plank cemetery, to wait the glad resurrection morn.
